### Appendix C: Participant Expectations

- Commit to participation so as to not deny another advocate an opportunity to join
  - Submit a participant biography slide
  - Attend both pre-work events and in-person workshop for the entire scheduled time
- Participate in independent pre-work, including:
  - 2 webinars
  - 1 week (*estimated time commitment – minimum 4 hours*) of self-led study – review provided slides, reading materials, websites, etc.
- Actively participate in in-person workshop
  - Ask questions and prompt discussions
  - Partake in open discourse with the group
  - Expand on questions or comments presented by other trainees
  - Share ideas with the entire class rather than forming subgroups or “cliques”
- Respect different viewpoints
  - Trainees should feel comfortable articulating diverse opinions and conflicting ideas
  - Engage in conversation – not arguments or reactions – about different viewpoints
  - Monitor your comments to ensure that you do not ramble, repeat yourself, or dominate discussion
- Interact with other participants
  - Converse and get to know other trainees
  - Support other participants’ engagement in the workshop
  - Encourage others to participate in discussions
  - Join in problem-solving
